Jesse Chasteen also served in the Revolution in Virginia as Jesse Shatteen in the infantry. Jesse was married to a widow, Ellender Wade Coffey, in Amherst County, VA. on Nov. 21, 1785. Mr. Faris states he has records of a Jesse Chastain in Halifax County, VA. just after the Revolution who had land dealings with a woman named Wade. I am of the opinion Jesse was a brother to James who also served in the Revolution. Both were married in Amherst County, VA. and both seem to have moved Madison County, KY., at or about the same time. Jesse appears first on the tax lists of Madison County, KY. in 1792. About 1801 Jesse moved to Wayne County, KY. and is named on tax lists as Jesse Shasteen through 1824. The name is usually spelled in this form in Wayne County records. He had a land patent in Wayne County of 193 acres on Otter Creek, dated April 4, 1805. He later moved to Tennessee about 1830.

(Jesse's wife Ellender wanted to live closer to her Coffey sons.)

Dear James,

I have been working on the James and Jesse Chasteen brothers and trying my best to find their parents. I am now working on Jesse Shasteen and need your help. Jesse's son, William B Shasteen, b. 1786, married Mary Levina Bowling Chastain abt. 1831, in Franklin County, TN. She was the daughter of John Chastain and Mary Robinson. Mary Robinson was born in Sullivan County, TN. and outlived her husband by 42 years. Her husband, John, son of Pierre, born 1743 and died 31 July 1805 in Pickens County, NC. I would think that she and her children went back to TN after his death.

Mary and William B Shasteen, named their first born son Rane H Shasteen, b. 1832. following children were named Margaret, Zachariah H, and Benjamin Berry. Why do you suppose they did that? Could Rane have been common to both of them? Have all of Rene Jr's (b. Jun 28, 1741) children been accounted for? What about Isaac, Rene Jr's brother?

Do you have any further documentation on this Mary Levina Chastain?

I find it very interesting that these two would get together unless they knew each in younger days, for instance, in Pickens County SC. I think James and Jesse were both in SC the same time as Pierre.

Jesse was also a minister of the gospel, James was responsible for founding a Church named Pleasant Run Missionary Baptist Church in 1820. Was there a church of that name in Rene Sr.'s background?

This information, along with the "Circumstancial" Mildred "Middy" Witt family connection, and of James marrying the d/o of a Witt, continues to build a case. I think they were grandsons of Rene Sr. but don't know which son yet, Isaac or Rene Jr.

Hey Jim,

You sent me, what I think, is a very valuable clue. Refer to your paragraph;

"Here are two others in VA that descendants are not known (if any), both sons of Jean Adam Chastain (son of Pierre and first wife Susanne Renaud), Pierre Chastain born 23 Feb 1729 in VA and Estienne (Stephen) Chastain born 9 Nov 1837 (and I have died in 1805 but do not have a source). The Pierre was not named in Jean Adam's will of 1760 so he might have died early."

Jean Adam, b. 1691 and Marianne David? had a daughter Marianne, b. ca,1715 She married Benjamin Witt Sr. 1731, Buckingham COunty, VA. She was the daughter-in-law of William G. Witt, of whom we have had much discussion re: his will and the fact he named a Peter Chastain as Executor.

I would think that this proves a relationship between Wm.G. Witt and Jean Adam. They certainly would have known each other. A sister of Benjamin, Sarah Witt b.ca. 1732, also mentioned in Wm Witt will, married John Canaday, this marriage produced Nancy Canaday 1756. She in turn married James CHasteen. James wife, Nancy, would have been the granddaughter of William G. Witt and a (niece of Marianne Chastain)

I show only two children for Jean Adam, Marianne and Jean (John) by his first wife Marianne (David?). The two sons of your mention, Pierre and Estienne were by his second wife Charlotte Judith Amonnet?

One of the things that really bother me is the Peter Chastain mentioned in William G Witt will. I believe this Peter (Pierre)1729, to be the son of Jean Adam and Charlotte above. He would be the half brother to Marianne who married Benjamin Witt, Wm's son. I think this Peter is the one who married Mildred "Middie" Witt.(No Proof) This would clarify the distinction between Mildred Archer, who married Peter of 1707, and Mildred Witt.

The Peter in Witt's will could also have been Jean Adam's nephew, son of Rene Sr. born 1736. I don't know anything about him.

This does not clarify the parentage of James and Jesse, but serves to provide a proven association with the children of the Jean Adam Chastain family. If we then think about Jesse's grandson named Rane, could there be a possibility that Jean Adam had another son named Rane, brother to Peter? Estienne also remains a good prospect.

I have to believe that Jesse and James are connected to Jean Adam in some fashion based on the above. Granted, no proof, but I think we are smelling roses here,

Hey Darrell, good to hear from you again!! I saw Pat Trocano at the PCFA reunion and she told me that you were still hot and heavy on the trail of James and Jesse. She also asked me to contact you concerning any SC connections that I might have for the two but just haven't had much time here lately for correspondence!!

I haven't done a whole lot of looking into Rev. John Chastain's descendants, just those that I ran across while

searching for Rev. James' descendants so I don't have a whole lot of personal documentation for them, just what others have submitted to PCFA or has appeared in The Chestnut Tree and the lineage text. But, will try to answer as best as possible.

As you mentioned, it seems fairly well documented (I don't have any sources though) that Rev. John's second wife was a Mrs. Mary (?-unknown) Robertson or Robinson. I don't believe, and don't see anything here in my stuff, that Mary's maiden name has been determined, I do have that she was born circa 1759 and died 12 Mar 1847 in Madison Co, AL (no source for this). They are noted as the parents of 3 children, Violet, William and Mary Lavina. Violet and William are noted in John's will recorded in 15 Jun 1803, Mary Lavina not born at this time.

I'm not quite sure just where the family ended up after John's death. John left the property to Mary and the minor children. The daughter Violet married William Akin, apparently in SC about 1815 and at some point relocated to Madison Co, AL. It appears that the son William moved into Habersham Co, GA (near to his half-brother, Benjamin) and married there to Margaret Dobbs in 1825. He also eventually settled in Madison Co, AL where he is located as late as the 1860 census but his family had moved to Massac Co, IL by the 1870 census. William was a preacher and apparently served churches in North AL and South central TN.

Mary Lavina seems to have married a Bowling first whose given name is unknown as she is noted with two daughters of this surname, Mary Ann and Martha Jane. Now, the oldest Mary Ann, has a birthplace noted as Tennessee in 1821, so perhaps there was a migration there prior to GA (where brother William was married in 1825) and then on to AL where Mary Lavina's second child, Martha, was born in 1826. Both were apparently raised by William Shasteen. From the data that I have, I can't determine if Mary Lavina married this Bowling fellow in SC, TN, or GA but perhaps they were married in 1820 and maybe were recorded in the census that year. Now, it appears that Franklin Co, TN is just NE across the line from Madison Co, AL where William Shasteen seems to be at least as early as 1826.

So, I don't know where the family might be 1805 to 1820 but it appears that at least Mary Lavina was in Tennessee in 1821 and then on to Alabama by 1826 if the births of the children are correct, possibly residing for a little while in Georgia where her brother is located. I would guess that she followed either William or both of her siblings (and mother it seems) to Alabama in the mid 1820's. This is probably of no interest but Mary Lavina married Samuel J. Weeks after the death of William.

The name Rene/Rane/Renny/etc. appears in at some point it seems in many Chastain lines, more common in some than others, not that common in Rev. John's descendants I don't think. I'm assuming that the origin in America is from Rene, Sr., Pierre's son. I looked through the descendants of Rev. John Chastain and there are only two grandchildren with this name, Rane H. Shasteen and Rainey Chastain a son of Edward Brigand Chastain (John-3, Peter-2, Pierre-1). And, Edward B. was born in the late 1760's so he probably knew or knew of his great-uncle Rene, Sr. and probably his uncle and cousin of the same name. With Mary Lavina being born 1803 and after her father's death in an area where there doesn't appear to have any more Chastains named Rene, I too now wonder if Rane is possibly derived from William Shasteen's side.

Rene Chastain, Sr. as you probably know migrated to a Huguenot settlement in SC (Abbeville/Edgefield and now in McCormick Co, SC) after 1778 and died there in 1786. It appears that his son Peter was in SC prior to 1780 but Isaac and Rene Jr. remained in Virginia. To the best of my knowledge, all of Rene Jr.'s children who lived to maturity are known but there is nothing known concerning Isaac's family or if he had one. Isaac is last noted in an advertisement in the Virginia Gazette searching for a lost mare in 1774. He was not named in Rene Sr.'s will of 1786 but there was mention of "my son" in Virginia, he later mentions Rene, Jr. (who was still in VA) so I don't know if the first reference is to Rene Jr. as well or possibly to Isaac. It is my opinion that Isaac is a good candidate for some of our unknown lineages if he could be associated with some circumstance. I don't know if this is worth mentioning but there was a Josp. (or Joel) Shatteen noted in the 1790 census for Rutherford Co, NC who is enumerated with a large family, several sons, and would appear to have been born prior to 1750. The reason that I say it's possibly not worth mentioning is, like James and Jesse, I have not been able to find any possible trace of this family in later records in SC or the adjoining counties in NC or GA. I've even

wondered if this fellow was a "Chastain" but at the same time I always go back to our James, Jesse, William, etc. with the idea that somehow he could be a potential father and that he possibly just after 1790 with the remainder of the family relocating elsewhere. That could be a stretch though. And, I would be at a loss to id Josp/Joel's father as well.

Likewise, I still wish we could determine just who the "older" James is who married apparently second to Pheobe Padgent in the same county, if my memory is correct, that James married in.

I don't have a whole lot here on Rev. Rene, Jr.'s church affiliations but don't see any reference to an association with a Pleasant Run Missionary Baptist Church.

Let me know if any of this doesn't make any sense or if I can possibly look up some more data to aid in this search. If I come across anything else I'll send on!! Jim
